RE: Authorization to Seek Funding for the Town of Barton Well Redevelopment

Dear Mayor and Village Board,

On behalf of the Town of Barton Town Board, this letter serves as formal authorization for the Village of Waverly to pursue grant and funding opportunities that include the redevelopment of the Town of Barton's well as part of the Village of Waverly Water Supply and Source Improvement Project.

The Town of Barton and the Village of Waverly operate interconnected water systems that are mutually dependent upon one another to provide reliable public water service to their respective residents and customers. While the existing ~~Intermunicipal~~ Agreement currently governs the Village's responsibilities for maintenance of the Town's well and the reading of the Town's water meters, both municipalities recognize that additional improvements are necessary to ensure the long-term reliability, capacity, and resiliency of the shared water system.

The Town acknowledges that the proposed redevelopment of the Town-owned well is a critical component of the Village's comprehensive Water Supply and Source Improvement Project and supports the Village's efforts to include this work in funding applications submitted to state and federal agencies.

The Town of Barton and the Village of Waverly are currently working collaboratively to develop a new Intermunicipal Agreement that will supersede the existing agreement. The new agreement is intended to establish the Village as the lead agency for implementation of the well redevelopment project, define each municipality's roles and responsibilities, and outline the financial and debt obligations associated with the project.

This letter is intended solely to authorize the Village of Waverly to seek funding on behalf of both municipalities for the proposed improvements while the updated Intermunicipal Agreement is being finalized. Execution of the new agreement will occur prior to the

commencement of construction and will govern the implementation and long-term operation of the project.

The Town of Barton appreciates its continued partnership with the Village of Waverly and looks forward to working together to strengthen the reliability and sustainability of the region's public water system.
